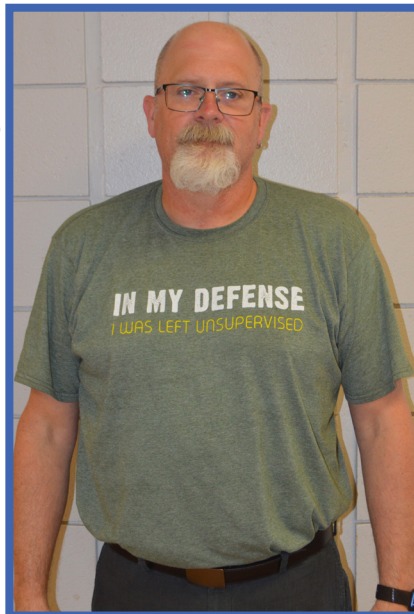




A King or A Knight?
