# Return to School Plan 2021 

GSSD will follow the current Public Health Orders and the advice and recommendation of the Local Medical Health Officer when revising the 2021-22 Return to School Plan.

Information may change as the fall progresses.
Take a look below at some of the steps we will be taking to ensure safety and well-being remain our number one priority for the 2021-2022 school year:

## Safe Attendance

- Students and staff who are ill should stay home
- An isolation area will be available if a student becomes ill at school
- Masks will be required for all students, staff \& visitors while in a GSSD facility
- Mask breaks will be encouraged based on local context
- Masking is not required outdoors


## Safe Transportation

- Assigned seating will continue
- Masks will be required for all riders

- Sanitization will continue
- No guest ridership
- Where possible, families are encouraged to take alternate means for students to get to and from school


## Safe Facilities



- Facilities will ensure that heightened sanitary and hygienic practices are in place
- Adequate soap and sanitizer will be available



## Safe Classrooms

- Hand hygiene will be promoted and practiced



## Instruction

- Full Saskatchewan curriculum will be taught
- Forward-facing instruction may be required based on local context


## Safe Activities

- Masking is not required during indoor Phys. Ed classes

- Extra-curricular and Co-curricular activities will continue with some restrictions based on Public Health Orders
- Sports, Fitness, Dance, Drama, Band, Choir will continue with some restrictions based on Public Health Orders
