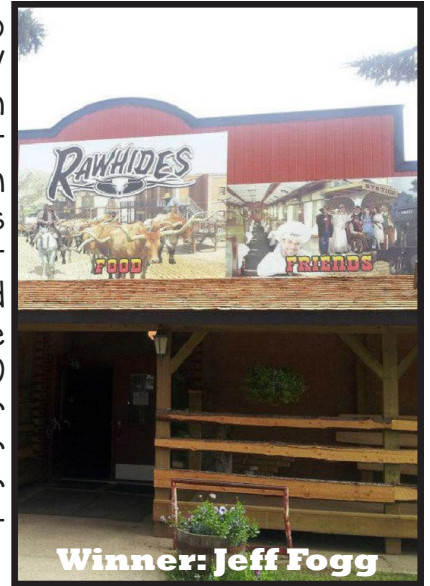


Schoolwide Birthday Raffle Fundraiser
